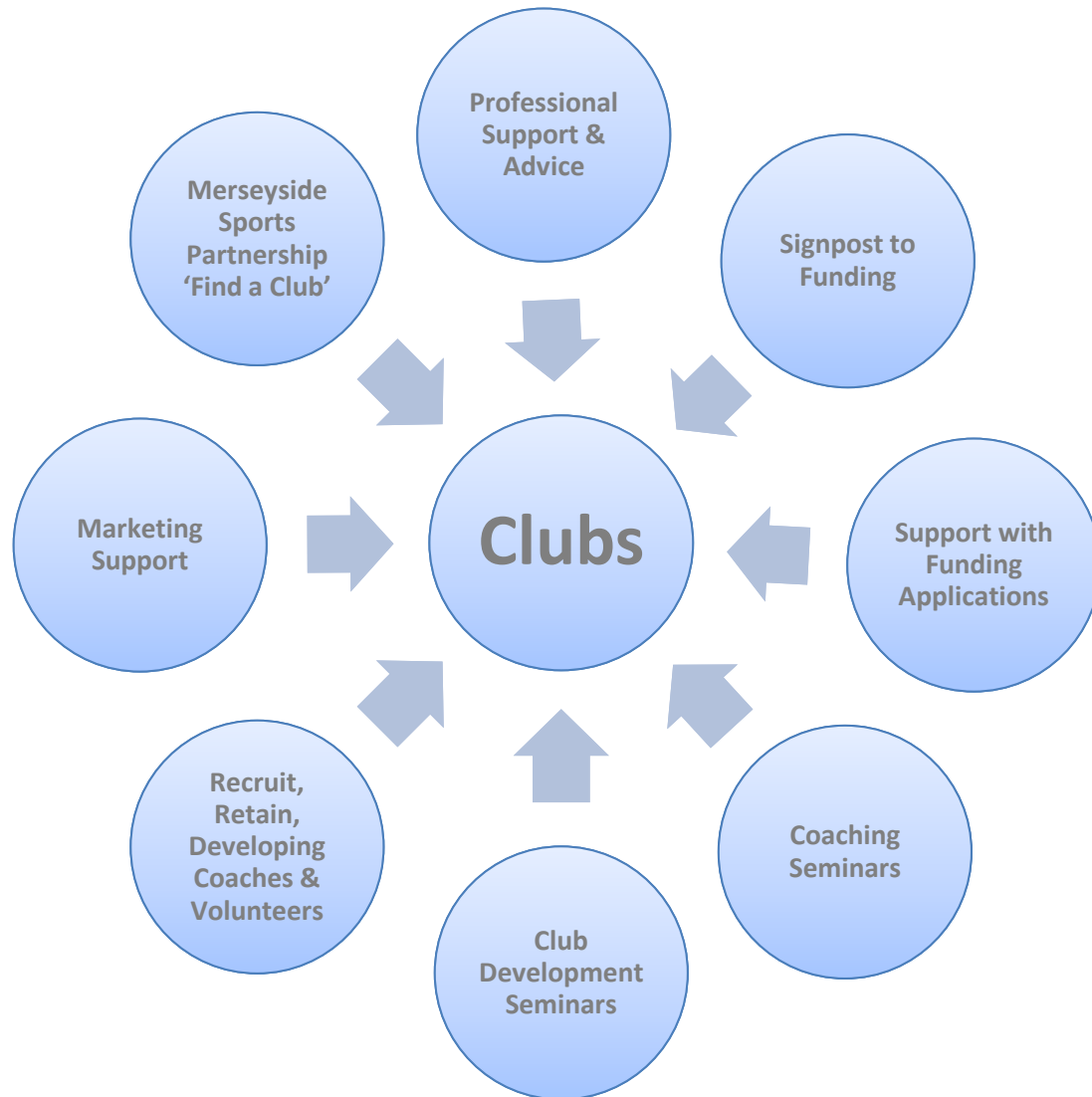

All constituted community clubs involved in sports and physical activity within Merseyside can have access to regular local support .

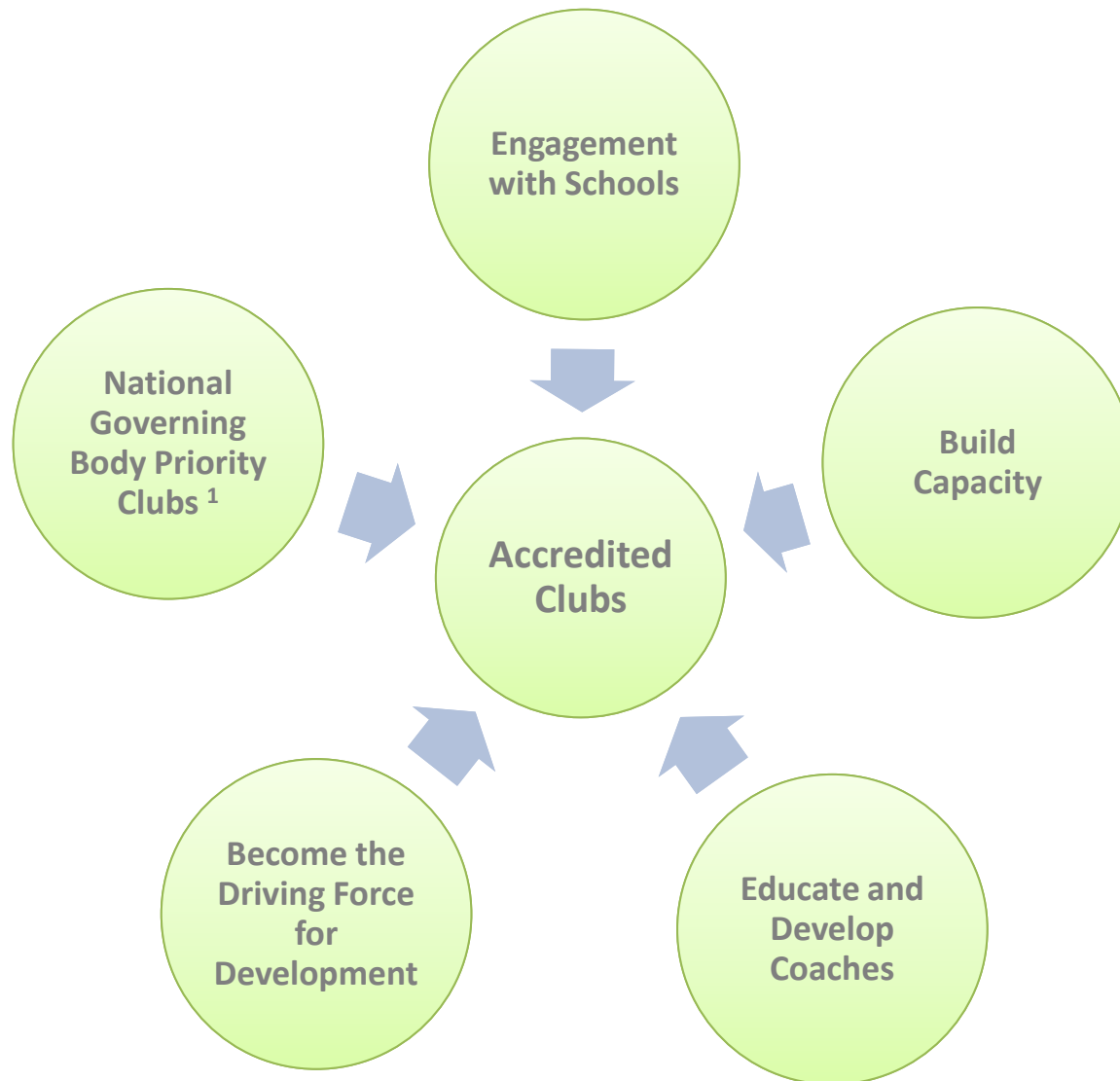
For your club, we will;

1. Provide support and advice from Sports Development professionals when required.
2. Signpost your club towards funding opportunities to support growth and sustainability.
3. Provide access to the Liverpool City Region Talented Athlete Programme to your elite athletes.
4. Provide professional support and advice with completing funding applications.
5. Provide access to local coaching conferences¹ and forums.
6. Provide access to local club conferences , forums and fairs.
7. Support your clubs with coach and volunteer workforce development.
8. Promote your club through local and partnership media.
9. Promote via the Merseyside Sports Partnership website.²

1. The Coaching Conference process may vary between each Local Authority – please contact your local Club Development Officer for full details in your area.

The Merseyside Sports Partnership - Enhanced Club Promise

Clubmark, Charter Standard and Locally Accredited

In addition to the club promise our Merseyside Clubs with local accreditation and Sport England / National Governing Body Clubmark¹ will be able to access an enhanced offer.

For your club, we will;

1. Provide support and advice for engaging with local schools.
2. Provide support and advice around building capacity within your club.
3. Provide enhanced coach and volunteer workforce development².
4. Support your desire to continuously improve by being the driving force for new projects and new developments³.
5. Become the National Governing Body priority clubs³, drive local priorities and top the list for investment.

1. Sports which have a NGB recognised by Sport England must work towards Clubmark accreditation instead of local schemes

2. Subject to local variances - plans to include access to Coach Manager Training from Merseyside Sports Partnership
